William Lehman Elementary Uniform Guidelines and Policy

The School Uniform Program is addressed in School Board Policy 5511-Dress Code and School Uniforms.

5511 - DRESS CODE AND SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Students are expected to come to school with proper attention having been given to personal cleanliness, grooming, and neatness of dress. Students whose personal attire or grooming distracts the attention of other students or teachers from their schoolwork shall be required to make the necessary alterations to such attire or grooming before entering the classroom or be sent home by the principal to be properly prepared for school. Students who fail to meet the minimum acceptable standards of cleanliness and neatness as determined by the principal and as specified in this policy shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary measures.

School Board Policy 5511, Dress Code and School Uniforms, requires all students in grades K-8 (Elementary Schools, K-8 Centers, and Middle schools) to participate in a mandatory school uniform program. Policy and process provisions allowing schools to select the school uniform will not be changed and no-uniform days may be authorized by the principal for specific proposes such a s fundraising, rewards, spirit days, and/or club days.

Selection of School Uniforms

The school uniform selected should not characterized as gender specific and should comply with all requirements set forth in School Board Policy 5511 - Dress Code and School Uniforms. Uniforms should be simple, inexpensive, and in colors that are carried by a range of uniform companies, retail stores, catalogs, etc.

All schools should include a "generic uniform", one that is easily obtainable from a variety of sources. The uniform chosen shall consist of (1) solid colored clothing and fabric for pants, skirts, shorts or similar clothing, and (2) short or long-sleeved shirts with collars. The uniform also may have a **logo but may NOT allow mottos** or slogans.

William Lehman Elementary Uniform Policy and Guidelines

Students:

Bottoms: long pants (no leggings), knee length shorts or skorts in khaki or navy Tops: polo/crew top shirt in white, light blue, dark blue or light yellow with school logo

Winter Attire

Sweaters or Jackets must be in navy.

Spirit Day Attire

Students may choose to wear a Spirit Day/Club Day shirt on designated days.

Shoes

Acceptable: closed shoes or sneakers

Not Acceptable: any open toe shoes such as open toes sandals, jellies, sling backs or clogs

Restrictions

· No oversized or undersized tops or bottoms are permitted

- Pants/shorts must be worn at the waist
- Undershirts worn under polo shirts must match the color of the shirt or white
- No sandals open toed shoes or shoes without back straps are allowed. Shoes must have backs.
- Cargo style shorts or pants are NOT allowed
- Leggings and jogger pants are NOT allowed
- Hoodies are NOT allowed
